What	Purpose
Young at Heart Column	Information to seniors about services and activities in Hutt City
Website	Revamp current seniors page on Hutt City website
Transport - Health	Redo current PHO brochure with new information, better design and wider distribution
Transport – Shops/social	Explore opportunities for shops to sponsor group transport
Safety	Work with Safe Hutt City to provide outreach to older residents
Roading and Traffic	To identify and establish a footpath network that meets the needs of mobility scooters to improve accessibility and mobility within Hutt City.
Accessible Parks and Gardens	Investigate opportunities to improve all seasons accessibility to Hutt City's main cemetery.
Housing – Community Support	Providing information about existing services, including Urban Plus tenancy selection and Hutt City curtain bank
Social Housing scoping exercise	UPL to work with Council in conjunction with the Urban Growth Strategy, with a goal of having a long-term social housing vision
